

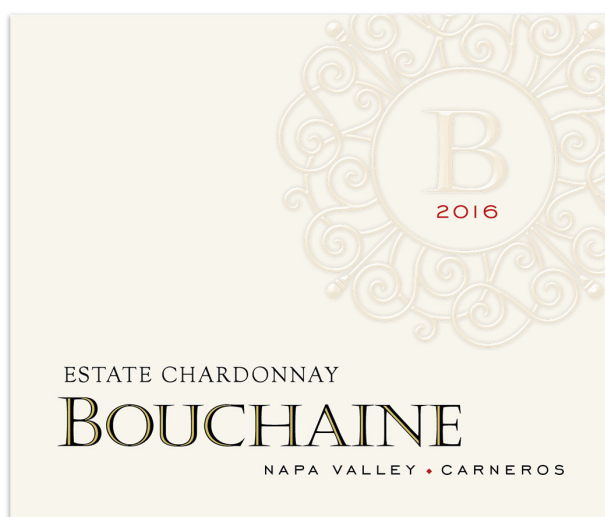

Chardonnay Napa Valley Carneros 2016

Score: 91 | \$32

**WS review:** Rich and fruit-filled, with well-focused apple pastry, peach, quince and tangerine flavors that lengthen out with buttery richness midpalate. The spicy finish features toasty notes. Drink now through 2023. 3,465 cases made.—Kim Marcus
